Time: 9:00 AM-11:00 AM

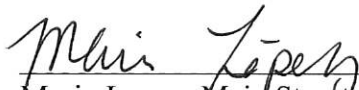
Location: Freeport Historical Museum, 311 E. Park Ave

Gov’t Code §551.001(4)(B)).
