 - ii. Brazos Cove;
 - b. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, environmental and permitting applications, environmental studies and Phase 1 work authorizations;
 - c. update on annexation matters; and
 - d. other engineering matters.
7. Detention maintenance matters, including approve updated maintenance schedules, and authorize appropriate action.
8. Report on development in the District.
9. Meeting schedule.
